

The word "disaster management" refers to all aspects of catastrophe mitigation, including preventive and protective measures, preparedness, and relief activities. There is Sendai Framework which was the first major agreement to it. The second category is activity post-disaster recovery in which response, rehabilitation, and reconstruction are all included. Search and rescue evacuation, meeting the victims' basic needs, and rapid medical support from regional, national, and international authorities were all part of the response phase. The disaster preparedness and planning procedure are the most effective at a grass-root level. In resource-scarce countries, ex-ante risk assuages investment in development planning is critical for decreasing disaster damage. It would be prudent to go from a risk-blind to a risk-informed investment decision. We cannot prevent disasters, but we can strive their severity and arm ourselves with knowledge so that too many lives are spared.
