The Pakistan government requested Wolpert to delete a few pages but the author rejected it. Benazir's government however allowed the book to be brought back and it went on sale after 1989.

The iconic novel "Dr Zivago", written by Boris Pasternak, was banned by Soviet Union in the 1950s. It was smuggled to Italy and then published in Milan but Pasternak won the Nobel Prize for literature.
