



So, what is it that we should pray for? As human beings, our knowledge of our lives and the world around us is limited. God, however, knows our past, present and future, and, as such, knows what is best for us. Our prayer to God should simply be for God's will, not our will, to play out in our lives.

What is the right technique for praying to God? There is a part of God that is already inside us, and prayer then becomes a communication with a divine power that resides within. God hears our prayers no matter what language in which they are uttered. What is important is the sincerity with which they are offered. When we come to God with humility, and when we surrender to God's will, we can be sure that peace, love, joy and harmony will prevail.

Prayer is a conversation where we talk to God. By contrast, meditation is a conversation where we listen to God and open up for God's grace in our lives. As we learn the technique of meditation, we learn the means to communicate with God in the right manner, such that we become recipients of the unbounded grace that is being showered in our direction.
