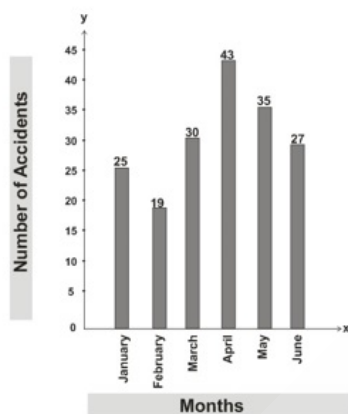

हिंदी-साहित्य के आधुनिक काल का आरम्भ सन् 1857 में हुआ, पर भारतवर्ष के आधुनिक बनने की प्रक्रिया की शुरुआत एक शताब्दी पूर्व(1757 ई.) तभी हो गयी थी, जब ईस्ट इण्डिया कम्पनी ने नवाब सिराजुद्दौला को प्लासी के युद्ध में हराया था। सिराजुद्दौला की हार के बाद सम्पूर्ण बंगाल पर अंग्रेजों का अधिकार हो गया। 1764 ई. में बक्सर के युद्ध में मुगल-सम्राट शाहआलम भी पराजित हुआ, 1765 में कड़ा के युद्ध में उसकी रही-सही शक्ति भी समाप्त हो गयी। सम्राट ने अब बंगाल, बिहार और उड़ीसा की दीवानी अंग्रेजों को बख्श दी। किंतु सम्पूर्ण देश पर आधिपत्य जमाने के लिए अंग्रेजों को दो अन्य शक्तियों को पराजित करना शेष था। वे शक्तियाँ थी मराठे और सिक्ख। सिक्ख तो पंजाब की सीमा में थे, परन्तु मराठों का प्रभाव बहुत व्यापक था। पारस्परिक फूट और संघर्ष के कारण असी(1803) और लासवारी(1803) के युद्धों में मराठे विजित हो गये और उनकी संघशक्ति समाप्त हो गयी। 1849 में सिक्खों को पराजित करने के बाद सम्पूर्ण देश अंग्रेजों के अधीन हो गया। 1856 में अवध भी अंग्रेजी राज्य में सम्मिलित कर लिया गया। अंग्रेजों की नीतियों से असंतुष्ट देशी राजाओं ने एकजुट होकर 1857 में व्यापक स्तर पर विद्रोह किया। फलस्वरूप ईस्ट इंडिया कम्पनी समाप्त कर दी गयी और भारतवर्ष ब्रिटिश साम्राज्य का उपनिवेश बन गया। अंग्रेजों ने अपनी आर्थिक, शैक्षणिक और प्रशासनिक नीतियों में परिवर्तन किया। इस देश के लोग भी नये संदर्भ में कुछ नया सोचने और करने के लिए बाध्य हुए। साहित्य मनुष्य के बृहत्तर सुख-दुःख के साथ पहली बार जुड़ा। यह प्रक्रिया भारतेंदु के समय में हुई—वह भी गद्य के माध्यम से। आधुनिक जीवन-चेतना की चिनगारियाँ जैसी गद्य में दिखाई पड़ीं वैसी पद्य में नहीं। नया युग अपनी अभिव्यक्ति के लिए नयी भाषा की खोज कर रहा था। ब्रजभाषा इसके लिए उपयुक्त नहीं थी, वह केवल पुरानी संवेदनाएँ ही अभिव्यक्त करती रही। खड़ीबोली – गद्य आधुनिक चेतना के फलस्वरूप ही सक्षम बन पड़ा।
