A large number of women in India are either ill equipped or not in a position to propel themselves out of their traditionally, unsatisfactory socio economics conditions. They are poor, uneducated and insufficiently trained. They are burdened by domestic chores and childcare responsibilities. There is an urgent need to encourage them to face the problems of illiteracy, lack of information and lack of skills, and try to find solutions to these problems. Education of women is a crucial input for improving nutrition levels, raising the age of marriage and their empowerment. The need of the hour is to improve female education which is the key to development of a nation. They should be made aware of their shortcomings in terms of education, nutrition and health. Human development is impossible without gender equality. Education in general and higher education in particular, is an insurance against economic exploitation of women. Access to higher education, which includes technical and professional competency, will guarantee economic independence of women leading to their equal socio-economic status.

5. Write the summary of the following English passage in 120 words:-**[20 Marks]**

Terrorism is an organized undeclared cold war against the sovereignty of the State. It is a crime against mankind. It targets innocent and peace loving civilians as well as security forces. It is a cowardly act by the terrorist groups who wish to disturb the peace of the country. It aims to create a state of panic amongst the people. They want to keep the people in a constant state of fear to stop the country from prospering. Terrorist organizations have established outlook across the world. They have paid informers and sympathizers including journalists. Some nations guide, give shelter and finance terrorist organizations in many countries. They recruit unemployed poor youth, train them in using guns and explosives and brainwash them to become terrorist. Every year in the last decade, several thousand innocent people were killed or maimed. Each death shatters families and leave behind widows and orphans. Terrorism has increased to such an extent that the patience of our citizens has been exhausted. Our neighbouring nation gives a helping hand to the terrorists to make violence and not to think of any development for the nation.

The anxiety and fear one has to live in restrict their way of living to a great extent. As terrorist attacks cause loss of life and property, the replenishment takes up a lot of capital. It also results in people leaving the country to settle abroad for a safer environment. Terrorism in all its forms and manifestations should be condemned.

Earlier the Parliament had enacted TADA / POTA to deal severely with terrorists. In some of the cases, it became successful. But it was withdrawn because the police used excessive force against the culprits. As we know our country stands on the policy of democracy, some political leaders raised a hue and cry for their vote bank politics. The press and the media started talking about fundamental rights in a Secular State, whereas they forgot about the plight of the victims of terrorist attacks in our country. The international community should rise above geopolitical vested interests in order to defeat the menace of terrorism.
