Alongside mitigating their carbon footprints through reducing emissions, there are basically three ways that states and cities are taking action. First, they are fielding hard engineering projects like sea walls, surge barriers, water pumps and overflow chambers to keep water out. The good news is that coastal cities are not starting from scratch – most of them have deep stores of knowledge and expertise. Many coastal cities have experimented with a combination of all three types of measures for hundreds of years. But past successes do not necessarily guarantee future safety. Today's cities are different from their predecessors. Many of them are of an unprecedented size and complexity.
