भूमंडल पर दृष्टि डालने पर पृथ्वी का 70% भाग पर पानी दृष्टिगोचर होता है किंतु पृथ्वी पर उपलब्ध जल का 0.007% हिस्सा अर्थात् एक लाख लीटर पानी में से 7 लीटर पानी ही मानव के लिए उपयोगी है, शेष पानी या तो समुद्री जल के रूप में या ग्लेशियर के रूप में जमा है। सारे विश्व में जल का संकट है किंतु भारत की स्थिति अधिक गंभीर है क्योंकि यहां दुनिया की 16% आबादी निवास करती है जबकि पानी केवल 4% ही उपलब्ध है। राजस्थान जो कि क्षेत्रफल की दृष्टि से भारत का सबसे बड़ा प्रदेश है तथा भारत के क्षेत्रफल का 10.41% भाग धारण करता है उसमें भारत का मात्र 1% जल उपलब्ध है। राजस्थान के अलग-अलग भागों में जल का वितरण भी असमान है।
